## **SCARs**

Severe Cutaneous Adverse Reactions are cell mediated drug hypersensitivity reactions occurring in certain population with genetical predisposition, resulting in severe and life-threatening skin and/or mucosal lesions, often associated with internal organ(s) involvement. The latency period (time from first ingestion of a drug to the time a drug reaction occurs) is as early as 4 days to as late as 8 weeks.

## Drug Reaction with Eosinophilia and Systemic Symptoms


- Incidence: 0.9-2/100,00 patients/year
- Drugs most commonly associated:

  Anticonvulsant (i.e., carbamazepine), antigout (i.e., allopurinol), antibiotic (i.e., sulfamethoxazole)



- Skin manifestations:
- Maculopapular eruption progressing to coalescing erythema, purpura, infiltrated plaques, exfoliative dermatitis, target-like lesions





Fever; malaise, facial edema; pruritic rash; lymphadenopathy; mild mucosal involvement; organ (i.e., liver/kidney) involvement
